HOUSE RULES

Bookings: All bookings should be made with our administrative team, available during office hours: Monday – Friday, from 9.00 until 17.00. For any questions regarding your booking, please do not hesitate to reach out by email (info@peacevillage.be) or by phone (+ 32 57/22 60 40).

Check-in rooms: Between 17.00 – 22.30. All guests receive bed linen and are responsible for making their own bed. Groups will be shown a video outlining our house rules. Early arrival is only possible on request. In that case, luggage can be stored in a designated area until the rooms are available at 17.00. The number of guests on the check-in form is solely for fire safety reasons and does not affect the final invoice (the numbers from the quote, and the general terms and conditions are used for this).

Checkout rooms: By 9.00; staying in the main building is allowed until 11.00 at the latest. Please return all used sheets and place them in the containers at the entrance of the main building. Pillows, duvets, and matress covers stay in the rooms. Please lock the rooms and return the keys to the reception.

Use of the meeting rooms: Free use of one of the meeting rooms during your stay; only on reservation! (Please specify time and activity.) The meeting room is available from 17.00 on the day of arrival until two hours after the last meal on the day of departure (until 11.00 when having breakfast; until 15.00 when having lunch). Provided there are no conflicts with other groups, the meeting room may be used earlier on the arrival day or longer on the departure day for an additional fee of €50 per room per day. The meeting rooms may not be used for commercial activities by groups not staying overnight at the Peace Village.

Use of sports equipment and games: Free during your stay and available for every group. All equipment from your sports cabinet will be controlled at checkout. Any damaged or missing equipment will be charged on the final invoice. Our set of folk games may be used for free as well, but only on reservation.

Meals: No outside food and/or drinks are allowed in the main building and meeting rooms. We provide meals for groups; self-catering is not possible. Special diets and allergies can only be guaranteed if the dietary information is submitted on time (4 weeks prior to arrival). All meal rates can be found on the price list.

- Breakfast buffet: 7.30 – 9.00 (included in the overnight rate)
- Packed lunch: prepared by guests themselves after breakfast, on request
- Cold buffet: 12.30, on request
- Dinner: 17.45 – 19.30, on request
- Barbecue: on request, subject to availability
- Afternoon snack: on request
- Coffee break/tea time in the morning and/or afternoon: on request

Bar: From 17.00 until 23.00, for guests only. The bar is closed during dinner service. During the day, drinks can be consumed from the assigned group fridge. These consumptions will appear on the final invoice. Bringing outside drinks is not allowed.

Rooms: The rooms are always allocated by our staff. Each room has its own lockable bathroom and a small lounge area. Access to each room is outside on the ground floor. The bunk beds are on the first floor, except for the rooms with disabled access (4 single beds on the ground floor). The twin rooms are located on the first floor and are for adults only. Please do not rearrange the furniture! 10 euro will be charged for a lost key. It is not allowed to enter any room other than your own.

Parking: Free parking is available in front of the main building (for guests only). Please do not park in front of the two green fire gates on the sides of the building. .

WI-FI: Free wi-fi is available. Misconduct may lead to expulsion for the entire group.

Animals: No pets, except for guide dogs, are allowed in or around our accommodation.

Safety: Each room has a fire extinguisher and all emergency exits are clearly indicated. In case of an evacuation, please gather at the assembly point on the football field. A water reservoir is provided for the fire brigade (no access for unauthorised persons). It is strictly forbidden to enter the kitchen or any technical rooms. The entire accommodation and the outdoor areas are smoke-free! Smoking is only allowed in the designated area on the side of the main building.

Ammunition is strictly prohibited in and around our accommodation. Please be extremely cautious with war relics. Without a safety certificate, they cannot be allowed on our site.

Damage and vandalism: The group is fully responsible for any damage caused. Defects or malfunctions in the rooms must be reported as soon as possible. All damage will be added to the final invoice. Prices can be found on the damage list.

Nighttime rest and noise: Out of respect for our neighbours and other guests, please keep noise levels to a minimum between 22.00 and 7.00.

Campfire: We have a campfire area at your disposal. Using our campfire area is only possible on request and with permission of the local authorities (please request at least one month prior to arrival). Guests should provide their own firewood and a bucket of water for safety.

Waste/Energy/Ecology: Plastics and drink cans, paper and cardboard, residual waste, and glass should be collected separately. Please keep all areas clean and do not leave any waste inside the building or around the accommodation. Please turn off the water, switch off the lights, and close windows and doors when the heating is on. The temperature in the rooms cannot be changed by guests. Water bottles can be refilled at the tap in our restaurant.

Lost items: All lost items are held for one month only. For any forgotten or lost items, please contact us as soon as possible. Guests can either collect their lost items from the hostel or have them sent via a shipping service. Guests have to pay for this service themselves.
